# From Mayor McNabb...

As I write this letter, our Public Works Department is working to clear our streets from the 3<sup>rd</sup> snow event of the winter. I sure appreciate their work. All of our departments step up when the weather is bad, and I am proud of the efforts they make to keep the city operating and all of us safe.

We are working to get bids out for projects for the construction season. We plan to overlay the rest of Panoramic and Cedar Street this summer. There will be several sewer and water projects completed. We will have a water line replacement on Wilkerson, a sewer line replacement on Blair, and we will be rebuilding the Camden Avenue lift station this summer. Some of the funds will come from ARPA money and the rest from regular revenue.

Speaking of revenue, our sales tax revenue continues to climb, and we appreciate your efforts to shop locally as much as you can. Sales tax is our main source of revenue and, if we are to continue to keep up with rising costs, we must continue to grow. I am grateful to see our established and new businesses working hard to attract and provide customers with the services and products they need.

We continue to get new business into the community. City staff works hard to make doing business in town as easy as we can. If we can help you achieve you dreams for your business be sure and contact us at city hall. We are here to serve.

The Park crew is busy preparing for the season and for spring and summer activities in the Park. There are many programs available, and I hope we have something for you and your family. The slide will be resurfaced at the pool, and plans are to redo the pool surface. This summer will be the first full summer for the 5,000-foot runway at the Airport. We saw lots of new activity last year and are preparing for record use this year. This creates opportunity for economic development all over the lake area.

# City Wide Garage Sale & Residential Clean Up COMING SOON!

The City of Camdenton is planning for the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual City-Wide Garage Sale. The Garage Sale is planned for Friday, May 5, 2023 and Saturday, May 6, 2023 with the annual Residential Clean Up the following week of May 8-12, 2023 on your regular trash pickup day. **More information will be in the May Newsletter.** 

The City will be waiving the garage sale permit requirement for May 5-6 only! This is a great way to pass on those "previously loved items" in addition to cleaning up the residential areas of our town.

## **HAVE YOU LICENSED YOUR PET FOR 2023?**

Public safety for the citizens of Camdenton is our number one priority. This is the reason it is so important for all citizens to license their pets. Section 210.090 of City Code requires all pet owners residing in the city to license all dogs and cats over six months of age. Licenses shall be effective from January 1st to December 31st of each year. A penalty is applied after January 31st. The cost is \$20 for a spay/neutered pet or \$50 for a non-spay/non-neutered pet. Camdenton does have a leash law which is enforced.

You may come to City Hall during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8 am until 4:30 pm to obtain your licenses. You will need to bring proof of current rabies vaccinations and spay/neuter information.

Your pet is an important part of your family, and City Officials understand that bond. For the safety of your pet and the safety of your neighbors, it is important to license your animals. This allows us to identify animals and return them to their owners if they are lost. We understand that they can escape your home or yard, and we want to assist in getting them home.

If you know of an animal running loose in your neighborhood, please call City Hall at 573-346-3604, and report the information. Please protect our pets and help us to keep our neighborhoods safe. As always, we are here to assist you in any way we can. Call if you have questions or concerns.

## **ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTIONS FOR BUSINESSES**

Businesses within the City of Camdenton are required to renew their business license each year by June 1. Renewal notices for businesses are mailed out in early April each year and are due by May 30 each year. A penalty will be applied for license renewals received after June 1 each year. As a friendly reminder, <u>ALL BUSINESSES</u> (new & those renewing) are <u>REQUIRED</u> to have an <u>ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION APPROVED BY THE CODE & FIRE OFFICIAL BEFORE THEIR BUSINESS LICENSE WILL BE ISSUED!</u>

IT IS THE BUSINESS OWNER'S RESPONSIBILTY TO CONTACT CODE & FIRE OFFICIAL CHASITY IVEY TO SCHEDULE THEIR ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION, 573-346-3600 ext. 233 or civey@camdentoncity.com. Your business license/renewal will not be valid until the Annual Life Safety Inspection is completed. This inspection is for the protection of you and your customers. # POLICE UPDATES



<u>Driving While Intoxicated:</u> The City of Camdenton's DWI statistics drastically increased from 34 in 2021 to 52 in 2022! Ten of those involved a form of an accident; luckily, there were not any fatalities. Just in the month of December, there were 11 DWI's. If you drink, PLEASE do not drive.

<u>Traffic Crashes Decrease:</u> Although the motor vehicle crash total is down from last year from 219 in 2021 to 209 in 2022, as a community, we can do better. Of the 209 crashes, there were 35 injuries and 0 fatalities. The Camdenton Police Department keeps record of each crash that takes place and the reasons. The top 3 reasons are: following too close, fail to yield, and improper backing. **Each crash is preventable!** 





Soon, the weather will be warming up, the flowers will be blooming, and the grass will be growing. Please be mindful of the city codes for the maximum height for your grass. Also, with the warmer weather, you may want to get out a walk your furbabies, but remember to keep them leashed and to pick up after them. If you have

## **CAMDENTON PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**


#### **RIGHT-OF-WAY WORK PERMITS**

The right-of-way, or roadway, is the full width of the roads in the City. Most roads are 50 to 60 feet wide with the center 20 feet paved. This means there is 10 to 20 feet on either side of the asphalt that is still roadway. These areas are used for official signage and utilities.

Work, such as driveways, require permission and a permit issued by the City. City ordinances prohibit placing any materials, signs, or structures within the right-of-way. This includes real estate signs, political signs, and portable basketball goals. While we want our children to exercise, basketball goals left in the right-of-way become a traffic hazard, and the owner of the goal is responsible should accidents happen. Please ensure the goals are moved back from the right-of-way after play.
